Problems (as we've seen them in 2007)

- no local awareness about touristic opportunities of the region
- no information about the region abroad, as a consequence, a total absence of foreign tourists
- huge distances to and between the would-be tourist objects
- local image of the steppe as a boring place which can only be used to get to somewhere

BUT...

- it's a classic steppe region, the most genuine Kazakhstan – so, steppe can be the main brand
- high level and old traditions of hospitality among rural population
- bad roads resulted in a number of unique wildlands
- ancient history is represented by rather attractive objects

Like everybody...

- financial support of international organizations (European commission, GEF/UNDP) at the beginning
- numerous workshops and trainings resulted in the network of rural homestays
- field investigations resulted in the network of tourist routes
- tourist information center in Karaganda
- handicrafts development
- cooperation with local authorities and protected areas' administrations






Travels through the steppes, from one mountain oasis to another (neo-nomadism)

Deep and creative elaboration of tours in terms of history, own investigations (only facts and theories, no profanation of history, links to the world history, tours "on the footsteps of...")




tailor-made tours constitute majority of the tourist packages, thus creating feeling of an adventure rather than a tourist trip both for the client and even for the tourism company staff




close co-operation with local authorities in terms of Central Kazakhstan promotion (travel fairs, publications, media-tours, etc.)
